Welcome to the Annual Report for the Department of Surgery. The past 12 months have been extraordinarily busy for everyone in the department. This increased tempo has been a reality for our surgical providers and the department's clinical staff.

The Department is comprised of two divisions, the General Surgery Division, and the Acute Care Surgery Division. The providers making up the General Surgery Division focus much of their clinical efforts in two subsets of care, one focusing on Women's Health-Breast Diseases and the other group focuses on broad-based general surgery. The Acute Care Surgery Division partners with Miami Valley Hospital and Premier Health, to manage and run the ACS-verified Level I trauma program, in addition, manage the patients on the Emergency General Surgery service. As you read further, it will become apparent that the pandemic impacted us in various ways; however, the past 12 months have been busy. Through all of this, the providers, clinical and the administrative staff have worked together to ensure our mission driven goals of Patient Care, Medical Education and Scholarly activity are achieved.

The mission of the department continues to be providing optimal care to the patients of our region, provide an exceptional educational environment for our learners (both undergraduate and postgraduate), and engage in scholarly activity that will advance the health of the region, as well as provide a platform to educate our learners. The general surgery residency program continues the long-standing and exceptional partnership with the US Air Force, not only in the training of the surgical residents, but partnering with our local active-duty surgeons to provide an operative experience outside of the base treatment facility. An area of ongoing pride, this year is our seven graduating chief surgery residents who spread out across the country, five entering general surgery practice (atypical for a surgery training program) and two who entered fellowships, one in vascular surgery and the other in solid organ transplantation. The program continues to train eight chiefs this year with a total of 42 trainees. The Fellowships in Acute Care Surgery and Surgical Critical Care will be training two fellows in the 2021/2022 year. Our recent graduate of the SICU Fellowship is continuing further training in the Chicago region.

The department's research efforts continue to provide a platform for resident and medical student achievement with publications and presentations throughout the year. The BSOM has begun a review of the research endeavors through the SOM, the department looks forward to being a strong partner in building our research activities to support our faculty in being productive in scholarly activities while caring for the patients they see every day.

As June came to an end, the department was looking forward to the naming of a new Chair of Surgery, which we expected by the end of summer. Anticipating the clinical pace in the upcoming 12 months has been difficult. From a clinical standpoint, our hospital partners have been inexplicably busy, and our office traffic remains at a brisk pace. The department's efforts are positively impacting the health of the various communities we serve and is fairly diversified across the two clinical divisions. We need to be watchful of overextending along with exhaustion and fatigue. Developing improved ways to complete the administrative tasks, as well as improving the provider's efficiency with EMR completion, will be crucial to further growth and protection of our providers.



Patient Care Summary


The following data includes both clinical divisions in the department. The department has two offices, one office located on the campus of Miami Valley Hospital in Dayton, and the second at Miami Valley Hospital South in Centerville. A few of our providers see patients at other offices in WSP, mainly the Sugar Camp Office in Oakwood as well as the WSP Health Center in Fairborn (adjacent to the WSU Dayton Campus). Additionally, a provider works out of the Soin Hospital Office Building in Beavercreek.

Inpatient Visits: We have new patient encounters both on the inpatient services the providers of the department run as well as through the outpatient office settings. During this reporting period, we had 3013 new patients in the inpatient setting, with an additional 1474 as observation status or emergency room visits.


Office Visits: The following is our new patient visits in the various departmental practice offices over the past three reporting years.
