1Statement from the Chair/Associate Dean

The Department of Pediatrics continues its commitment to supporting and advancing high quality undergraduate pediatric medical education, graduate medical education and continuing medical education, clinical services, and research.

92% of the Class of 2022 ranked their pediatric clerkship as good/excellent, placing BSOM near the 75th percentile nationally. Medical students consistently report that the pediatric clerkship is the best organized of the 3rd year doctoring experiences.

The Department provided career advising and departmental support for 10 members of the class of 2023 who matched in pediatrics. Nearly 50 voluntary faculty provided pediatric primary care clerkship experiences for students during the pandemic. Miriam Lader, MD has exceled in her role as clerkship director and was recognized with the BSOM Excellence in Medical Student Education Award for 2023. Rebecca Elofskey provides outstanding support and coordination of our medical students' experiences in pediatrics. Jasa Talarico has done an exceptional job as our first pediatric career advisor.

The Integrated Pediatric Residency program successfully matched 9 civilian and 7 Air Force students to join the Department in June 2023 while sustaining and refining our innovative model for virtual recruitment. Two of our incoming residents are graduates of BSOM. The graduating class of 2022 is serving children across the United States at 6 Air Force Bases, including Wright-Patterson, 6 additional general pediatric practices, and in fellowships in neonatology and hospital medicine. 2023 graduates are embarking on primary care careers across Ohio, the United States, Korea, and Japan, as well as fellowships in Hematology-Oncology and Endocrinology.

We successfully launched Pediatric Hospital Medicine and Pediatric Emergency Medicine Fellowship programs and filled 2 positions in each program in our second match. The Hospital Medicine program is led by Amy Jeffers, MD and Kathleen Matic, MD while the Emergency Medicine program is led by Richard Strait, Md and Pradeep Padmanabhan, MD, MSc.

Continuing Medical Education continues to be an important focus in the Department of Pediatrics, highlighted by the annual Neuroscience Symposium and by offering 1787 hours of CME credit in Grand Rounds in 2022-2023.

The DCH Center for Health Equity, launched in July 2021, has opened 8 research studies, and submitted their first NIH grant proposal. There are currently 212 open research studies at Dayton Children's Hospital, including 37 members of the Department of Pediatrics as principal investigators.

Faculty published 88 papers in peer-reviewed journals from July 2022 to June 2023. Faculty in the Division of Pediatric Infectious Disease contributed articles in the April 2022 issue of Current Problems in Pediatric and Adolescent Health Care, which was edited by faculty member John Pascoe, MD, MPH.

The Dayton Children's Hospital Foundation Robert C. Cohn Memorial Research Grants were award to Melissa King, DO, Shannon Nicks, PhD, MPH, and Pinki Chowdhury, PhD. Dr. Chowdhury continues research on chemotherapeutic strategies against childhood-diffuse intrinsic pontine glioma. Dr. Nicks, associate director of health outcomes research, is using photovoice methodology to assess health equity and its impact on the black community's mental health and service utilization. Finally, Dr. King is pursuing

a quality improvement project involving the management of non-alcoholic fatty liver disease with dietary, physical, and behavioral health interventions.

Dr. Nicks was selected as one of ten scientist nationally for the Health Affairs 2023 cohort of early career health policy researchers Health Equity Fellowship for Trainees.

With the ongoing investment from Connor Kids and Community Partners, we have expanded behavioral health services, offering innovative approaches to prevention, early identification, and management of social and emotional issues in the pediatric primary care setting. Dr. Suzie Nelson, child and adolescent psychiatrist, joined the team in 2022. Our residency's longitudinal curriculum in behavioral health received national recognition at the Pediatric Academic Societies and Association of Pediatric Program Directors annual meetings.

Sherman Alter, MD, Dan Lacey, MD, PhD, Stephen Wolf, MD, and Eileen Kasten, MD retired after many years of dedicated service to BSOM and DCH!

Jordan Wright, MD was named the Chief of Hematology-Oncology, Katherine DeMasie, MD as Chief of Anesthesiology, and Tahira Adelekan, MD as Chief of Developmental-Behavioral Pediatrics. Luxme Hariharan, MD, MPH joined Dayton Children's as Chief of Ophthalmology.

Gogi Kumar, MD, Chief of Neurology, was promoted to Professor of Pediatrics at Boonshoft School of Medicine.

Ten faculty are active members of BSOM Committees.

Faculty and staff in the Department of Pediatrics continue to be poised to support the mission of the Boonshoft School of Medicine as the future unfolds.
