

STRATEGIC PLAN 2022–27

THE PLANNING PROCESS

In spring 2021, the Boonshoft School of Medicine began a planning process that intentionally engaged diverse stakeholders to reflect on the organization's goals for the next five years. Dean Valerie Weber first convened a steering committee composed of representatives from the school's leadership. This committee met twice in the summer and early fall of 2021 to conduct strategic visioning sessions around priorities and needed resources.

In December of 2021, four workgroups were charged: Undergraduate Medical Education, Graduate Medical Education, Research, and Clinical Care. Workgroups consisted of faculty and staff across the Boonshoft School of Medicine. The broader community completed a survey to build upon ideas from the diverse membership of the workgroups.



Each workgroup prioritized up to five strategic goals for their area. In March of 2022, the groups presented their findings to the Steering Committee, which then reviewed and prioritized five overarching goals for the school. The group identified strategies, timelines, resources, and indicators of success for each objective. The broader community had the opportunity to reflect and comment on the draft strategic plan before it was adopted by the Executive Committee of the Faculty in June of 2022.

A NATIONAL MODEL

OBJECTIVE

The Boonshoft School of Medicine will be a national model of outstanding community-focused medical education, responsive to the workforce needs of Ohio and the Miami Valley.

- We will make improvements to the White Hall facility to support enhanced capacity for student learning and wellness.
- We will enhance student-facing services, including mental health, career advising, and academic advising, to assure student success.
- We will create excellence through ongoing monitoring of LCME standards through its QI processes and governance committees, ensuring outstanding accreditation outcomes.
- We will continue to expand our vision for diversity and inclusion to create a supportive environment for all.
